

Immerse yourself in the incredible archipelago of Bocas del Toro, where you'll explore coral reefs, mangroves, and rainforests while supporting afterschool centers run by Give and Surf.

Spend your mornings learning about eco-tourism initiatives, waste management solutions, and efforts to restore the area's endangered coral reefs from local sustainability leaders. In the afternoons, you'll work with local teachers to engage students in play-based learning activities and connect with the Afro-Caribbean and indigenous Ngöbe communities.

You'll also spend two nights at a locally-run hostel on Cristóbal Island while learning from the Ngöbe indigenous community. Along the way, you will be immersed in the Spanish language, connect with local residents, hike to empty beaches, and snorkel coral reefs.

This open enrollment program is available to any student with a spring break from March 9-16, 2024. Priority is given to students from SStS partner schools who have spring break at this time.
